Free Job Training?

The BuildingWorks Pre-apprenticeship Training Program is conducting a 15-week, full-time training program in the building trades and general construction. Training hours are 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m, Monday thru Friday. All training is FREE. Lunch, transportation, and all training materials are also included. There are no stipends, however.



This program is for Essex/Hudson County residents only. Exceptions are made at the discretion of management/administrative staff.



BuildingWorks is ideal for individuals interested in beginning a career in the construction trades, including, but not limited to, carpentry, electrical and environmental remediation. Applicants must be able to fully commit to a training schedule for all 15 weeks, must have a high school diploma or GED, be physically able to work, and must take an admission exam in math and reading. All enrollees must pass a drug screening.

All program candidates MUST attend a two-day Remediation in reading and math on October 5th & 7th (8:00am-4:00pm ALL DAY) in order to be eligible for further consideration and admittance to our Information Session & Testing.
