

Haiti Disaster Relief Fund!

The photos are devastating and the need for action is now.

Rotary is an international organization with 50 clubs in Hudson, Bergen and Passaic Counties. There are several area Northern NJ Rotarians in Les Cayes about 120 miles southwest of Port au Prince. They were there doing community projects in Les Cayes at the time of the earthquake. Now refugees are pouring into that city seeking food, medicine and shelter. To assist in meeting that need, the fifty local Hudson, Bergen and Passaic Rotary Clubs are being challenged to raise \$250,000 by the first week in February. The Secaucus Rotary Club will try to raise \$5,000 as our share of the relief effort.

One of the Rotarians in Haiti said he is staying in Haiti to work with Haitian Rotary Clubs to organize assistance. Another Rotarian left Haiti to collect funds and medical help. This week Rotarian Peter Kikot from Ridgewood Rotary is going to Haiti to distribute relief to the people that need it. Peter has chartered a flight and is picking up two doctors in Ft. Lauderdale and then flying to Haiti with a plane load of supplies.

The people of Haiti need our help and the Secaucus Rotary Club needs yours. On Monday February 1, the collected checks will be turned over to the Rotary relief committee and then taken to Haiti.
